

#### Keeping You Informed

The State of Maine has determined that they require 2 doses of varicella and 2 doses of measles, mumps and rubella for healthcare workers and a history of the disease(s) is not acceptable to prove immunity. Proof of immunity with a titer (lab work) is acceptable as an alternative.

With that noted, the task for our Infection Preventionist was to review all employee files to identify the employees who needed to have a varicella and/or a MMR titer. Some of our employees have been identified to need titer(s). If you are an employee who has been identified, you will receive an email with instructions.

- A varicella titer, also called a varicella antibody titer test or VZV titer, is a blood test to check for your immunity to chickenpox due to previous vaccination or infection. It checks for chickenpox antibodies in the blood.
- An MMR titer is a blood test that checks for immunity (from prior vaccination or infection) to the Measles, Mumps and Rubella infections. We thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
